July - September is the raining season, it cooled down the heat and brought the joy to the crops. However, this year we were hit by couples of depression, one of them caused the flood to KGS corn farm at the back of the shelter.

It's been 3 months since the government eased the lockdown which s seeing every sector coming to life again. Communities have opened for outsider to visit, therefore, we took the opportunity to do the community outreach to 7 communities of our girls' village.

Peer Educator Training

6 of KGS youth leaders took part in the Peer Educators Training in Chiang Saen, District, Chiangrai Province as facilitators. This was a good opportunity for them to practice and grow their skills in leadership and presentation with confidence and proficiency. The pre and post-test administered indicated that the training was well received and of benefit to the participants particularly showing they learned and have a better understanding about child right, human trafficking and online threat.

Scholarship Provided to 80 Students

Community Field officer represented the Keep Girls Safe project in presenting scholarships to 9 schools in remote area of Chiangrai Province. Sincere gratitude to our donors for your kind support, which enables these underprivileged students to continue their studies. Some of them have been selected as peer leader to train and enlighten other students about Child Rights, Anti – Human Trafficking and Online Threat.

Besides cooking, girls also learned how to make desserts. This time, they made Taro & Coconut Milk Pudding!! It was very creamy and yummy!

As it's a raining season, our vegetables have been bountiful. We intend to sell surplus in the local market with our own branding. So far, we have sold, mushroom, morning glory and angle loofah. We got the compliment from the buyer said "your mushroom are so huge!"

To improve the handicraft skill, KGS invited the teacher from Phan Learning Center where 5 of our girls were under training in June. This time, the teacher taught to make hairband, hill tribe bags, and coin pocket with the 5 girls as facilitators.
